## **13. 14 & 15 July 2007**

### **At Horsens Showground**

#### General rules

##### **Where will the Shettival be held?**

The show will take place at Horsens Showground, Hattingvej 2, Horsens, Denmark.

##### **Who is eligible to take part?**

All ISPC-countries are invited to participate in the show.

All pony owners have to be members of the Shetland Pony Society in their own country to participate in the show.

##### **Requirements for the ponies:**

Only registered ponies, with a maximum height of 107 cm. which are bred by a licensed or breed approved stallion will be allowed to participate, this applies to all classes.

The Danish ponies must have a declaration, stating that the ponies are healthy and from disease free stock. Vaccination is not required.

International rules apply to the ponies from abroad.

##### **The Shettival office:**

The Shettival office at the showground will be open:

Thursday 12 <sup>th</sup> of July	12.00 to 19.00

Saturday 14 <sup>th</sup> of July	08.00 to 18.00
Sunday 15 <sup>th</sup> of July	08.00 to 18.00

##### **Arrival:**

Arrival at the showground can begin Thursday at 12.00, unless other arrangements have been agreed by the organisers.

All ponies must have arrived at the showground, by **Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> of July at 08.00.**

On arrival, take your signed declaration to the Shettival office, where you will be issued with a number for your ponies and directions to your box reservation and camping facilities if required.

##### **Non Attendance:**

If a pony is unable to attend the show, please phone Anne-Grethe Monk Hansen on her mobile: 00 45 20 80 05 44.

##### **Departure:**

The ponies can leave the show ground at the earliest on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> of July at 16.00.

**Box reservation:**

It will be possible to rent a box and/or stall. Only 2 ponies (or a mare with foal) will be allowed in each box.

Reserved boxes and stalls will be available from Thursday at 12.00.

There will be straw in each box/tether space on arrival.

Please ensure that all boxes are left clean and tidy on departure to ensure return of your deposit.

Further straw can be bought at the show ground, however you will need to supply your own hay, feed and buckets.

Please note, that according to Danish legislation, all ponies must have access to water day and night. It is the handler's responsibility to observe this rule.

**Veterinary:**

**Camping:**

There will be a campsite available, for participants' caravans and tents, please note that it is necessary to reserve a space. (See below for prices and entry forms).

There are toilets and showers available on the campsite.

There are also a limited numbers of caravans available for rent.

To reserve camping space or a caravan please contact the Shettival office.

The camping site will be open from Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> of July at 12.00.

**Timetable for the classes:**

*Friday: 13 July*

20.00 Official opening. All nations will be represented by their flag and 3 ponies.

A small refreshment will be served.

*Saturday: 14 July*

08.30 All Handling classes begin.

Morning: Handling classes for the older ponies.

Afternoon: Handling classes for young ponies, in conjunction with dressage, cone driving and children's activities

The schedule has been planned so a pony can participate in more than one discipline. We expect the judging of the older ponies to end on Saturday morning, in order that they will be able to participate in the working classes and the children activities in the afternoon

19.00 Dinner/Dance. All drinks MUST be purchased at the bar.

*Sunday: 15 July*

08.30 Children's activities and marathon driving.

14.30 Championships.

16.00 The Show closes.

The activities mentioned above will take place depending on the number of competitors taking part and we reserve the right to change the programme accordingly. The precise schedule for the different classes will appear in the catalogue.

**Participation in the show and your presence at the showground is at your own risk!**

**Handling classes:**

The judging will be carried out by judges from Denmark - Great Britain – Norway – Sweden and Holland.

**Dress code:** Competitors are expected to abide by the rules set by their own country.

**Class division:**

In class 1 and 2, the foals are classified as:

Miniature: Under 70 cm. (Incl. 70 cm.)

Standard: Over 70 cm.

In class 3 and 8 the ponies are classified as:

Miniature: Under 84 cm. (Incl. 84 cm.)

Standard: Over 84 cm.

The rest of the classes will be divided in following sizes:

	3 years old.	4 years and older.
Mini	Up to 85 cm.	Up to 86 cm.
Miniature	86-94 cm.	87-95 cm.
Standard	95-102 cm.	96-107 cm.

The height of the pony must be shown on the entry form.

The right is reserved to measure the height of a pony if there is doubt over it's correct measurement.

**Judging**

The judging will take place in a grass ring.

The ponies in the handling classes must be shown in the triangle formation.

Stallions of 2 years and older must be shown in a head collar with the lead rein fastened to the bit.

Handlers of stallions must be 15 years old or over.

The judges will give points from 1-10 for:

- 1: Type.
- 2: Conformation.
- 3: Limbs.
- 4: Movement in a walk.
- 5: Movement in a trot.

The judge's comments on the ponies can be collected from the Shettival office immediately after the class ends.

Rosettes will be awarded to all participants.

### **Championship:**

All winners from class 1-14 will take part in the championship on Sunday afternoon.

There will be a champion from each of the following groups:

- Foal champion
- Filly champion
- Colt champion
- Veteran champion
- Mini champion and res. champion
- Medium champion and res. champion
- Standard champion and res. champion
- Over-all champion and Over-all res. champion

It will be possible to enter the following classes:

- 1: Filly foals
- 2: Colt foals
- 3: Fillies 2 years old
- 4: Fillies 3 years old
- 5: Mares, 4 years old and over, with a dependant foal
- 6: Mares, 4 years old and over, without a dependant foal
- 7: Veteran mares 15 years old and over
- 8: Colts 2 years old
- 9: Breed approved stallions 3 years old
- 10: Licensed stallions 4 years
- 11: Licensed stallions 5 years old and over
- 12: Licensed veteran stallions 15 years old and over
- 13: Geldings
- 14: Veteran geldings 15 years old and over.
- 15: Family collection – min. 3 ponies by the same stallion or out of the same mare.

No pony under 2 years of age is eligible.

**Working classes:**

The pony must be 4 years old or over in the driving or ridden classes.

Coachmen under the age of 16 and all riders must wear a helmet. The same rule applies to children under the age of 11 that take part in classes 20, 27 and 29.

The judging will take place in a grass ring.

There will be a prize presentation after each class.

Rosettes will be given to all participants.

**Children Activities**

Beginners:- Riders that have never competed before in a competitive show.

Intermediates:- Riders that have taken part in small competitions, but have never won.

If in doubt, the Shettival organisers will decide.

**Ridden classes – jumping:**

16: Beginners with lead rein, 10 years and younger.

17: Beginners. Jump height 30-45 cm. Open for all beginners of acceptable height and weight.

18: Intermediates. Jump height 50 cm. Open for all intermediates of acceptable height and weight.

19: Open class. Jump height 68 cm. Open for all riders of acceptable height and weight.

**Agility:**

20:\* Children up to 10 years old (Incl. 10).

21:\* Junior from 11-17 years old.

22:\* Senior

**Ridden classes – dressage:**

23:\* Beginner with leading rein, up to and including 10 years of age.

24:\* Ridden class without gallop, up to and including 12 years of age.

25 Open ridden class with gallop, for all riders of suitable height and weight.

**Costume class:**

26: Own choice of costume.

Leading rein class.

Riders up to and including 10 years of age.

The pony and/or the rider will dress up in a fabulous costume, no limits to how imaginative the costume can be.

The judges will award 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places.

**High jump – with handler on foot:**

27: Junior – Up to and including 17 years old

28: Senior.

The pony and the handler will jump over one obstacle. The height will start at 30 cm. and will gradual increase,

The equipages will jump in turn and stay in the competition for as long as they don't knock the jumps down.

The winner is the equipage that jumps the highest.

**Trotting race – with handler on foot:**

29: Junior – Up to and including 17 years of age.

30: Senior

The handler is running next to the pony. The team able to run 100 m. in the shortest time is the winner.

You will be disqualified if your pony starts to gallop.

The winners from the preliminary classes will meet in the final.

**Pony games:**

31:\* Leading rein class, up to and including 10 years of age.

32:\* Open class for all riders with suitable height and weight.

\* = Further details for the classes will be sent directly to the participator.

**Driving:**

**Disciplines**

The following disciplines will take place:

Driving dressage: Beginners will drive the FEI-programme 3  
Experienced will drive the FEI programme 6. The programmes will be available on: [www.koereforbund.dk](http://www.koereforbund.dk)

Cone driving: You will drive through 10 gates + start and goal. The gate breadth is the carriage width + 30cm

Marathon: After warming-up, 2 marathon obstacle courses are driven by each participant twice. The best time for each obstacle round will count as the final score.

It is possible to participate in all 3 disciplines or in just one particular discipline if you prefer.

Your choice must be made clear on the entry form.

**Classes:**

It will be possible to enter the following classes:

**Single, pair or four in hand.** There have to be at least 4 participators, before a class will take place

The participators will be divided between experienced and beginners. The beginners are those who haven't driven in a competition before.

If there is any doubt the organizers will decide.

**Single:**

- 33: Dressage – Beginner. FEI – programme 3
- 34: Dressage – Experienced. FEI – programme 6
- 35: Cone driving – Beginner.
- 36: Cone driving – Experienced.
- 37: Marathon – Beginner.
- 38: Marathon – Experienced.

**Pair:**

- 39: Dressage – Beginner. FEI – programme 3
- 40: Dressage – Experienced. FEI – programme 6
- 41: Cone driving – Beginner.
- 42: Cone driving – Experienced.
- 43: Marathon – Beginner.
- 44: Marathon – Experienced.

**Four in hand:**

- 45: Dressage – Beginner. FEI – programme 3
- 46: Dressage – Experienced. FEI – programme 6
- 47: Cone driving – Beginner.
- 48: Cone driving – Experienced.
- 49: Marathon – Beginner.
- 50: Marathon – Experienced.

There must be an adult helper available all the time if the coachman is under the age of 12.

Coachmen and helpers must wear helmets in Marathon and it is recommended to use a riding safety vest.

The ponies in all driving classes must be at least 4 years old.

Single is driven without a helper in the carriage.

Pair has 1 helper in the carriage.

Four in hand has 2 helpers in the carriage.

There will be one winner in each class and an over-all winner of those who have taken part in all 3 classes :- dressage, Cone driving and marathon.

**Time schedule:**

The time schedule will be worked out, when all the entry forms are received and it is possible to tell how many participators will be entering the show and how many classes there will be available.

If it is possible the time table will be planned so that it is possible for 1 pony to enter in more than one discipline.

The time table will be printed in the programme.

**The last day to enrol is the 15<sup>th</sup> of April 2007.**
